# Scope of Bulletin 3

As everybody is getting ready for the event, we want to supply the latest information to prepare the participants for their journey and their arrival in Meiringen. The Bulletin is also explaining how to access the airfield the first time, where to register and which documents need to be prepared.

# Local Rules for F4C and H and F4K to be applied at the Championships

Please be aware that there were some rule changes passed at the April 2018 CIAM Plenary Meeting. Such changes usually only come in force from January of the following year. Since these changes are either clarifications or procedural changes, the Plenary Meeting gave permission that they could be implemented immediately as "Local Rules" for the event. The rule changes including the manoeuvre list can be downloaded from the WC website.

2018 FAI World Championships F4 Local Rules Amended Manoeuvre List for F4C and F4H, May 2018

Since Bulletin 3 will be sent to all team managers and published on the WC website, we are assuming that all teams and pilots are made well aware of the local rules.

# **Delivery of Personal Data**

All participants have entered the most important information including a portrait picture and a picture of their aircraft into the online scoring system. This information can be seen already on the championship website and will be used for the real time scoring system. We have already drawn the needed information to produce the official printed program brochure. Each participant will receive the official printed program brochure as part of his welcome package at registration.

# Entering optional manoeuvres online

Each participant is in possession of his personal login. We have just activated the option to select the individual optional manoeuvres. All pilots are kindly asked to enter their optional manoeuvres well in advance of the contest. The optional manoeuvres can be selected independently for each round and may be modified by the participant himself until he enters the ready box. At the ready box, there will be an assistant from the scoring team who will display the selected manoeuvres to the pilot or his helper. If needed, last modifications can be done there. For documentation purposes, the optional manoeuvres will be printed out.

# **Transportation and Supplies**

In Bulletin 2, information was provided on the transportation and importing of the model aircrafts and on the possibility to get the needed supplies on site. Just very few teams have contacted us with requests or questions so far. Therefore, we assume that there are no open issues regarding this. # First entry and registration


Since we are flying on an active military airbase, each participant needs his personal identification badge to enter the site. At the first arrival of his team, each <u>team manager</u> has to follow the below procedure:

- 1. Parking of the team's cars at the official parking <u>lot A</u> for all pilots and TM
- 2. Walking to the information office B (460m)
- 3. Registration at the information office in the 1st floor of the hangar 1, only TM
- 4. Presenting at registration with passport of all pilots and helpers
- 5. Provide the needed forms (list see below)
- 6. Receipt of the welcome packages including all personal identification badges
- 7. Receipt of the event vouchers
- 8. Instructions for car access in order to unload models will be given at this moment to the TM

Needed forms

- <u>Anti-Doping Declaration</u>, filled in and signed by each participant
- <u>Competitors Declaration Form</u>, confirmed/stamped by the respective NAC, including two copies
- Model Specification Certificate, confirmed/stamped by the respective NAC

After the first entry, all participants may access the site via the guard-house, where they need to display their personal identification badge or via the public entrance. Cars need to be parked at the pilots parking area lot A. If car access is needed during the contest, please contact the information office.





# Model processing

Model processing starts on Thursday July 5 in the preparation shelter at the F4C/H flight line. Each team will be allowed to check the weight of their models before their official processing starts.

# **Practice Flights**

Practice flying will take place from Wednesday, July 4 until Friday, July 6. Contrary to Bulletin 2, there will be no scheduled practice flying. Instead, we will apply an open practice flight scheme on Wednesday and Thursday, while there is plenty of time for all teams. Of course, there will be an official person like the flight line director at the flight line to assist if needed. On Friday, practice flying will be assisted and supervised by the flight line director, who will ensure that each team gets an equal chance to issue practice flights. Since this open scheme does not comply with the rules, but was successfully applied at the last two WC in favour of the participants, we ask the team managers to object if needed within one week time from Bulletin 3 publication.

Practice flying takes place at the very same place as the contest flights. No practice flights will be allowed for the duration of the contest after the first round of flying has commenced. In case of a model damage and repair during the contest, we will arrange for a test flight.

# Weekly Schedule
